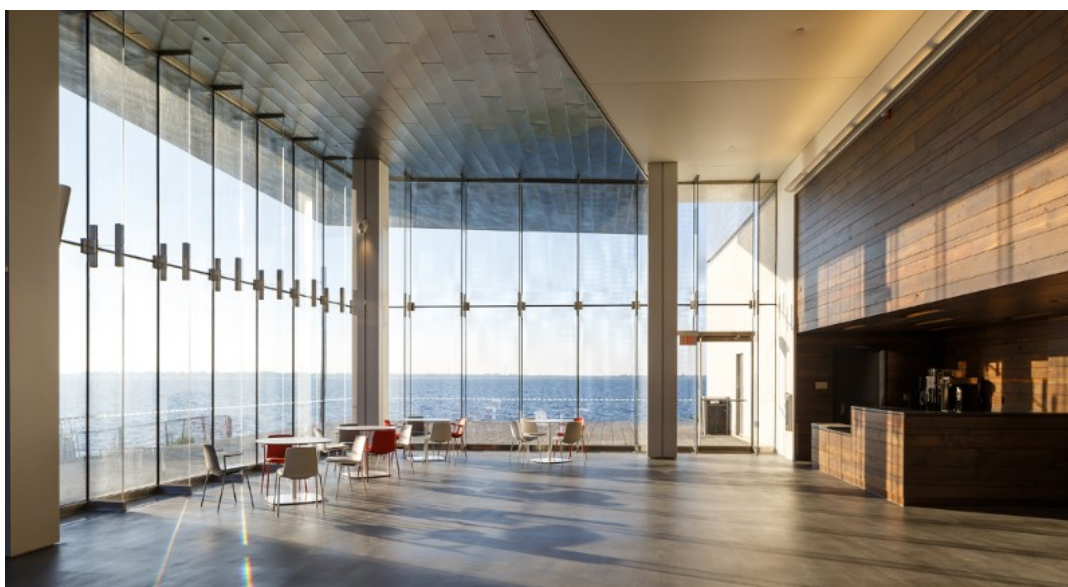

In order to register for the conference, you must be a member of CATR for 2018. You can join or renew your membership from the same URL as conference registration.

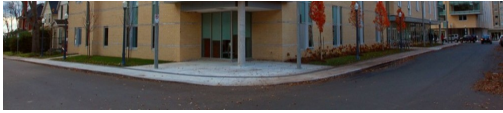
To register, go to www.catr2018.wordpress.com and follow the links to REGISTER.

Eligible applicants are required to:

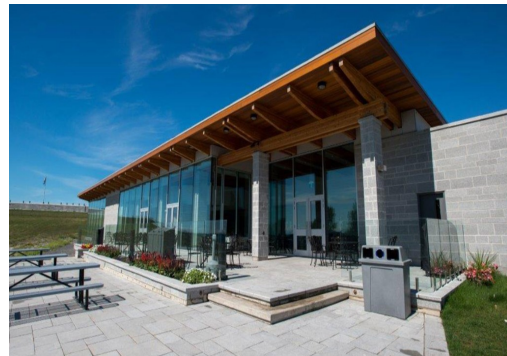

Note: if you are driving or taking alternative means of travel without a standard ticket or bill, please provide a statement indicating origin of travel, means of travel, and kilometrage.
